ADOBE LICENSE CHANGES

All eligible University of Utah community members who wish to use Adobe products are required to activate a new software license, which remains free to students taking for-credit classes and full-time faculty and staff.

Eligible Adobe product users are asked to evaluate their university-related needs and obtain the minimum software that supports them. UIT recommends Adobe Express Premium for most users.

MICROSOFT 365

1. Visit o365cloud.utah.edu.
2. Select the "LOGIN" button.
3. You will be directed to a "Sign in to Microsoft 365" login page.
4. Enter your uNID@umail.utah.edu email address and select "Sign in."
5. You will be redirected to a University of Utah authentication page or dialog box, depending on your operating system and browser.
6. Enter your uNID and university password. You may be prompted to authenticate with Duo 2FA.
7. Select "Install and more" and "Install Microsoft 365 apps."

CONNECTING TO WI-FI

UConnect is a secure, 5GHz connection meant for phones, laptops, and tablets that requires a valid uNID login.

UGuest is a less secure, open-access network for campus and hospital visitors who need temporary access.

Ulink is the university's wireless network for Internet of Things (IoT) devices, such as PlayStation, Xbox, Roku, Chromecast, etc., that requires a valid uNID login.

Eduroam allows students, faculty, and staff from participating institutions to obtain internet connectivity on campus, at Salt Lake Community College's Herriman campus, and at other participating institutions.
