



Final reminder: Legacy DNS will be turned off on 11/30/18

You are receiving this email because you are subscribed to UIT's public email list.

This is a final reminder that University Information Technology (UIT) is migrating DNS from the current B1-4 infrastructure to the new AnyCast environment. DNS calls from devices that aren't updated by **November 30, 2018** will cease to function. As the deadline approaches, we're reaching out again to urge points of contact (POCs) to migrate before that date.

The list of IP addresses that still need to be migrated is in [Box \(authentication required\)](#). Please review the list to see if you need to migrate any devices.

POCs for listed IPs need to change their devices to AnyCast (172.20.120.20) for DNS functionality.

To get current DNS names of IP hosts that need to be updated for AnyCast, POCs can run an "nslookup" on the IPs.

This change was announced in the [February 2018 IT Pros meeting](#) and in the [March 2018 Node 4 newsletter](#). In July 2018, POCs who had not yet moved their devices over were contacted directly.
