Effective July 2019, the University of Utah will add a new prefix to the list of available prefixes used for U telephone numbers. The additional prefix is necessary to accommodate the increasing need for new telephone numbers assigned to U employees and offices. All current prefixes will continue to be used.

Additional prefix: 646 (e.g., 801-646-XXXX)

Existing prefixes: 213, 581, 585, 587

Whenever you reference your telephone number, please remember to always provide the full 10-digit telephone number, which includes the area code, prefix, and last four digits. Providing your full number helps to prevent people from accidentally using an incorrect prefix.

A university-wide communication campaign about the new prefix is underway. Please help to spread awareness by communicating with your faculty, staff, and students about the new prefix.
