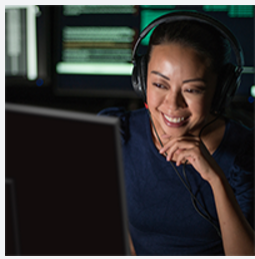

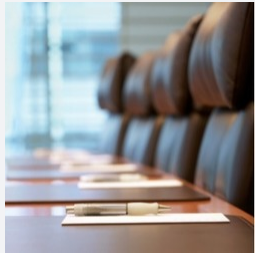


2022 ITIL 4 Foundations class dates announced
