## 2 announcements: 3/8 change to Sympa index access; Configuration change to improve Outlook performance

## 1. Sympa maintenance with downtime on 3/8 will affect access to list index

To reduce the volume of spam sent to Sympa lists, UIT will make a change on **Friday**, **March 8**, **2019 from 7:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m.** that will restrict public access to the U's Sympa index of lists (aka, "Lists of lists"). Sympa lists will be unavailable during the maintenance window. This will impact all Sympa lists hosted at lists.utah.edu, lists.hsc.utah.edu, lists.law.utah.edu, and lists.cs.utah.edu.

After the change, University of Utah Sympa users may continue to access the index of lists once logged in to Sympa. List owners may request to make their list(s) publicly accessible in the index of lists by opening a service request: UIT Help Desk at 801-581-4000, option 1; ITS Service Desk at 801-587-6000.

## 2. Configuration change recommended to improve Outlook client performance

Microsoft has recommended that the University of Utah enable "Cached Exchange Mode" to enhance the performance of desktop Outlook clients and their connections to UMail servers.

**If you manage your own Active Directory**, we urge you to implement the Group Policy Object (GPO) configuration change below to improve the performance of your users' Outlook clients.

To set up a GPO and force the Outlook Exchange mode:

- Download the Administrative Template (ADMX) files for your version of Microsoft Office
  - Office 2013 ADMX template
  - Office 2016 ADMX template
- Install the files, then copy them to %systemdrive%\Windows\PolicyDefinitions
  - Copy ADMX files to base folder
  - Copy ADML files to en-us subfolder
- Open the Group Policy Management Editor to create a new, linked GPO or modify an existing one
  - GPO path = User Configuration > Policies > Administrative Template
